

Statement of Guiding Principles

The Board of Directors of the Dubuque Community School District is charged by the State with the responsibility for providing educational opportunities and for directing those activities, which the State entrusts to its care and supervision. A carefully planned pattern of authority is established and observed by the Board. The Board acts by establishing policies and evaluating results.

The Board of Directors shall have the further duty of managing the finances by which the educational program is conducted. They shall also ensure that the community is informed of the needs, purposes, values, and status of the schools.

The Board of Directors shall appoint a Superintendent who will act as the executive officer of the Board and be held responsible for execution of all its policies and such other duties as assigned by the Board.
