

### **Permanent or Temporary Student Transportation Services**

There may be instances in which a student might be permanently or temporarily in need of special or general transportation services but not designated as a recipient of special education services. The student, if entitled to transportation by statute or district policy, would be entitled to transportation services only to the extent that the district is capable of providing it. Options to the district include transporting on a district owned vehicle, contracting with a private party or parent reimbursement.

Parents of general education students must submit a request for services to the Transportation Department. Included on this request must be a diagnostic statement from the child's physician explaining the disability, the approximate length of time transportation would be required and a release of information so district nursing personnel may discuss the child's medical condition with the proper physician.

A decision will be made by the district from input by the district's Health Coordinator, Section 504 Coordinator, the Building Principal, and the Transportation Department.
