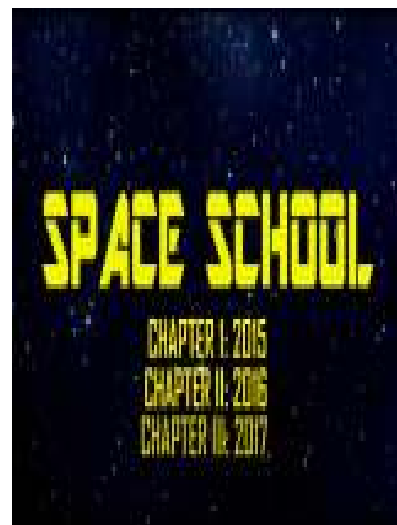
Preschool registration will begin on Monday, February 2nd. Packets may be picked up beginning at 7:30 a.m. First-come, first-serve.

Mrs. Atencio's 5th graders are collecting gently-used clothing for children until Thursday, February 5th. Thank you!

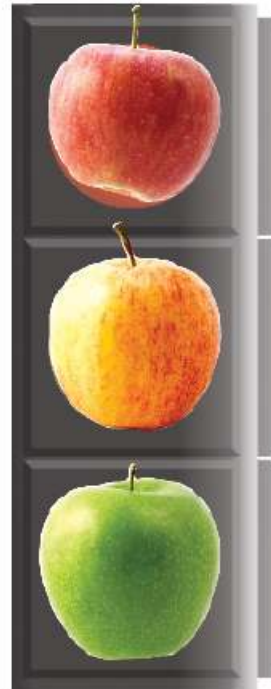


5th Grade Movie, Coming to you
