Counselor Corner-Mrs. Kaiser

During the week of November 3rd – 7th I have been in preschool thru second grade. In preschool, we discussed what makes a good friend and watched a book-a-look on *Horace and Morris but mostly Dolores*. In kindergarten, the students put a puzzle together as a whole group and had to use their best teamwork skills. In first grade, the students did the activities passing the hula hoop and the human knot. They were put into small groups of six and as a team had to work through their activity; once completed they wrote about the activities in their journals. In second grade, the students did the activity snakes and trust. The class was divided in two groups and

stood in a line blind folded, the student in the back would give directions through touch and this had to be communicated through the whole line. The person at the beginning of the line then took that direction and looked for their ball and were to place it in the bucket. Second grade students also wrote in their journals about working as a team. Next week I will be in third thru fifth grade, we will continue to focus on collaboration skills.
