WELCOME TO DUBUQUE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL AND THE 2017-18 SCHOOL YEAR

We hope your summer has been fun and relaxing. We are preparing for an exciting new school year and are committed to providing you with an educational experience to prepare you for future success!

Registering your student(s) for the 2017-18 school year starts with eRegistering each student on PowerSchool. This process involves updating demographic information, as well as paying fees online. You can access the website at www.dbqschools.org/backtoschool to complete this part of the process. If you have any questions regarding this process, you may call the main office at 552-5500. We will also have assistance available during our registration days, if needed.

The second step to register for the 2017-18 school year is to come to **ROOSEVELT MIDDLE SCHOOL** on **Wednesday, August 9th or Thursday, August 10th**. At this time you will pay fees (if you have not already done so online), pick up your schedule, have your student ID photo taken, receive your locker assignment, pick up yearbooks (upper class students), and receive more information regarding this year. **If you have pre-paid your fees and eRegistered, you will still need to come to registration to pick up your receipt and go through the rest of the registration process.** You will also have an opportunity to purchase your Jule Youth Bus Pass (\$10).

All 9th graders and new transfer students will begin their school year on **Tuesday, August 22nd from 7:35 a.m.- 2:20 p.m.** Please report to the Nora Gymnasium for our **New Student Orientation program provided just for you.** Time will be provided for checking your schedules, a review of activities and student handbooks, a tour of the building, a shortened regular school schedule, lunch and a question/answer session.
