Grade 4-5 Vocal Music Concert: Our vocal music concert for students in grades 4 and 5 will be held Thursday, December 7th, at the Eleanor Roosevelt Middle School Auditorium. Please make sure that your student leaves his/her coat with you, as students will be dismissed directly from the concert and will not be returning backstage. The performance will begin at 6:30 pm and will last approximately 30-40 minutes.

Secondary Open Enrollment Applications for Grades 6-12: Open Enrollment Applications for students in grades 6-12 for the 2018-2019 school year will be available at the district administration building (2300 Chaney Road) and online at www.dbqschools.org/parents/quick-links/open-enrollment/ beginning January 15, 2018. Applications will be accepted through March 1, 2018 for initial consideration. All applications received after the March 1 deadline will be held for consideration after registration in August of 2018.
