Counselor Corner...Mrs. Boeve

Greetings! For the month of December, the focus of our classroom guidance lessons are Protective Behaviors. The goals of the lessons are for students to understand appropriate and inappropriate or confusing touch and know who to tell about these unsafe situations.

Students in grade K through 3rd review the process of NO/ GO/ YELL/ TELL if faced with an uncomfortable situation. NO/ GO/ YELL/ TELL includes: Say NO as loud as you can, GO away from the situation as fast as you can, YELL or should "Help" or call 911, and TELL a parent, teacher, or other trusted adult close by.

Students in grades 4th through 5th were introduced to lessons on peer pressure to know when it's affecting their decision making and ways to appropriately cope if it occurs. We hope that through these lessons, students feel more confident in their abilities to advocate for themselves and easily identify resources to keep them safe.
