Greetings in the New Year!

This month's focus for guidance lessons is the topic of "Working Collaboratively." The goals for K-2 grade students are to understand group rules, learn skills to be a productive group member, and respect differences. The goals for 3-5 grade students are to understand group rules and roles, learn skills to be a productive group member, and respect differences and compromise. As adults, we know these skills play a role in every day life in every day settings such as work, home, family, and community. The more often we use these, the more success we're likely to have when working in groups. Majority of the classes participated in a team building activity during guidance to practice these skills in a safe, monitored setting. We then discussed as a class the good team work skills that were used to accomplish a task such as a puzzle. Ask your student how they use team work in the settings they encounter such as sports, school, home, family, and community!
